Responsibilities

- 1. Mentor Recruitment: Seek out a diverse and knowledgeable group of mentors for each hackathon track, ensuring a wide range of expertise and backgrounds.
- 2. Communication Facilitation: Establish and maintain effective communication channels between mentors and participating teams, ensuring mentors are available for guidance and support.
- 3. Mentor Onboarding: Create comprehensive onboarding materials for mentors, providing them with necessary information about the hackathon and their role as mentors.
- 4. Team Matching: Guide mentors through the team matching process, helping them find suitable teams to support based on their expertise and interests.
- 5. Mentor Check-Ins: Regularly check in with mentors throughout the hackathon, addressing any communication issues with teams and providing assistance as needed.

- 6. Engagement Opportunities: Develop and implement strategies to foster more engagement and interaction between mentors and students, such as workshops, panels, or networking events.
